- Admittance into the Farmers Market is at the sole discretion of the Lodi District Chamber of Commerce. If not accepted into the Market, payment will be refunded in full.
- Payment must be made in full two weeks before your first market.
- There will be NO refunds for dissatisfaction of sales or booth location, change of mind, no-show or inclement weather.
- Vendors must abide by the market's rules and regulations as well as those of the Lodi Police and Fire Departments, State Board of Equalization and Health Department.

VENDOR RESPONSIBLE:

- Reading, understanding and following all Lodi Farmers Market Rules and Regulations. These rules and regulations are available online at www.lodichamber.com or at the Chamber office.
- Assembling and staffing own booth
- Purchasing/supplying all food, materials and equipment necessary to properly and safely run the booth.
- Comply with all Police and Fire Department Rules and Regulations (Fire Department: 209-333-6735)
- Collection and handling of money for their business
- Booth display sign(s)
- Adhering to Environmental Health Department Regulations
- Cleaning your area after the event. Leaving no trash. Space MUST be left as found.
- No selling outside of your space is allowed.
- Complete and sign the mandatory Liability Clause below. Return original signed copy with Application. Keep a copy of all paperwork for your records.
- You may not serve beverages or additional food other than what is listed and approved.
- Food vendors must provide a copy of their certificate of liability in the amount of \$1/\$2 million naming the Lodi Chamber as additional insured.

- Completed and signed 2026 Farmers Market Application
- Liability Insurance must be enclosed with this Application
- San Joaquin County Temporary Food Vendor's Application
- A copy of a valid seller's permit
- Payment in full with application

- San Joaquin County Temporary Health Event Permit
- Advertising
- Sending vendor space assignment

IMPORTANT DETAILS:

RAINOUT POLICY: The Market will take place RAIN or SHINE or HEAT. There are NO rainout refunds!

FULL attendance is necessary, if miss more than 2 weeks, you will be dropped from season
